

Fact sheet for training institutes in the field of occupational safety

Approved by the SPKP on 09/12/2022, updated on 05/28/2025 and valid from 07/01/2025.

temptraining's latest conditions always apply to the approval of training institutes. These are published on the <u>temptraining</u> website. The provisions below also apply.

temptraining determines which courses fall within the field of occupational safety. The training institute must meet various conditions for temptraining to include or continue to list it in the register.

Training institutes*

Training institutes accepted by temptraining that offer occupational safety courses must always be listed as an educational establishment in one or more of the following lists (this list is exhaustive):

 Educational establishments for personal protective equipment for the prevention of falls (PSAgA) courses:

Load handling:

Institutes that comply with the SUVA guidelines www.suva.ch/33099.d fact sheet "Training for load handling on cranes" can submit their course description to temptraining for inspection.

^{*}Training institutes listed in the training network displayed at SUVA are no longer listed under the occupational safety category if they do not meet the criteria in this fact sheet.

SUVA XR (Swiss Safety VR):

Training institutes that would like to offer occupational safety courses with VR goggles must use the content created by SUVA. These courses must also be approved by SUVA. Further information on this can be found at Swiss Safety VR - Virtual Reality for Occupational Safety

The accepted training institutes can offer courses in other categories, provided they meet the relevant temptraining criteria.

ASA specialists

Training institutes approved by temptraining that are not listed on one of the lists specified above must have occupational safety specialists who meet the requirements of the regulation on the suitability of occupational safety specialists and who keep their training up to date accordingly. The further training and its duration are set out in the further training regulations of the professional associations:

ASA specialists as per the SUVA list:

- Swiss Society for Occupational Hygiene (SSOH)
- Swiss Society for Occupational Medicine (SSOM)
- Swiss Society for Occupational Safety (SSOS)

Quality management system

The training institute should have a quality management system with one of the following Swiss certifications: eduQua, Q2E, EFQM, ISO 29991 et seq.

The courses must be run by these specialists.

Special cases

Training institutes included on one of the following lists are not added to the occupational safety category by temptraining, but rather to transport/logistics (there is no quality management system admission criterion in this case):
